The Tropical Storms is a five week development program of the Forest Lakes Hurricanes Swim Team (FLST). It is designed to be an introduction to the competitive swim team. This program will provide the basics of competitive swim strokes. This program is not a substitute for swim lessons.

Tropical Storms are for children 4 years old and all <u>new</u> swimmers under 7 years old.

The program will introduce young swimmers to the swim team style of swimming and advance them to be able to swim at least 1 pool length (25 meters) of Freestyle and Backstroke. This 45-minute practice is intended to be an introduction to the swim team. The Tropical Storms goal is to encourage as many young swimmers to enjoy the swimming sport in a fun and friendly environment. They will practice 3 times a week, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday from 12:00-12:45 at the South Pool.

Dear Forest Lakes Residents,

School's out and a busy summer of tennis is just around the corner.

I want to remind all residents that the courts are for tennis! Not for training your dog. Not for dumping your dog's doo doo. Not for changing your baby's diapers. Not for depositing your baby's soiled diapers. Not for soccer. Not for baseball batting practice. Not eating your lunch. Not for stick ball. Not for loitering. Not for listening to the latest heavy metal release. Not for cussing up a storm. The tennis courts are for tennis!

The Spring USTA team seasons are coming to a close over the next couple of weeks. The reconstruction of the South hard courts is going well, albeit delayed due to the wet weather in May. The men's and women's singles ladders have been rebooted for this tennis season. And tennis remains a very popular activity for Forest Lakes families. All of this contributes to a high demand for court time at the North Clay Tech courts.

I advised all players to sign up for courts on the Court Reservation clip board at the entrance to the Pro Shop. Please respect the "This court is reserved..." flyers that are posted at the entrance to the courts at various times. Respect the next group of players that will use the court by brushing and lining the courts after you have finished your playing session. Please hang up all brushes and liners on the fence after you finished grooming your court. Please do not allow young children to use or play with the liners and brushes. Their "artwork" is not appreciated by the tennis faithful.

The very popular Forest Lakes Summer Junior Tennis Camp gets underway on June 13. Sign up information is available at the FLCA website or at the Pro Shop. I can also forward the information and answer questions, just contact me via my email below, or stop by the courts and see me.

All tennis players should note that the Junior Camp will use four courts from 9:30 am-3 pm every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. Thursday is match day, with some matches using all six of the North courts from 1-3:30 pm. (Many of the Thursday matches are at other facilities around town.) All Junior Camp activity will temporarily move to the South courts when that construction project has been completed. The Junior Camp will return to the North courts after the repair work has been completed there.

There will be some evening and Thursday morning adult instructional and training offerings beginning later this month. I am also available for group and private lessons by appointment. I am also stocking up on close out rackets, and have a wide selection of strings and grips in the Pro Shop. Contact me for details.

Suffice to say, it will be an interesting, but exciting, month or two ahead when it comes to playing tennis at Forest Lakes. Please plan ahead, and have patience.

I am looking forward to the new and improved courts at both Forest Lakes tennis sites. I hope the residents of Forest Lakes will take pride in the appearance and condition of the new and improved amenities.

Keep our courts clean and have a great time playing on them.
