





DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

Some residents have made changes to their property without ARB approval and have had to remove the changes or modify them to meet the Forest Lakes Community Association (FLCA) Guidelines.

If you plan to make any changes outside your home, it is important that you first check the guidelines to be sure that it is an acceptable modification. These guidelines are found on the FLCA web page under "ARB Guidelines" or you may obtain a hard copy from the office. You also received them when you moved into Forest Lakes with your Homeowner's Packet.

Most changes will require that an ARB request be completed and turned in for Architectural Review Board approval before starting the project. The request form can be found on the FLCA web page under "FORMS" or may be obtained from the office. Common types of changes that need ARB approval are:

- Additions to the property (e.g. Deck, Awnings, Basketball Backboards, Dog Houses, Fencing, Play Equipment, Retaining Walls, Sheds, Spas, Energy Collection Devices, Rain Water Collection Receptacles, Roofing etc.)
- Color changes to the home (e.g. Shutters, Doors, Siding, etc).
- Landscape Changes (e.g. Tree Removal, Gazebos, and Walls etc.)

Processing of ARB request generally take less than a week from the day it is received at the office. The ARB Committee thanks you and your neighbors thank you as well!

BROOKHILL UPDATE

FLST SWIM MEETS

There are two remaining swim meets to be held at the Forest Lakes South Pool. They will be held on Wednesday July 6th and Wednesday July 20th. The pool will close at 3:00pm on each of those days to prepare for the meet. The North Pool will be open as usual. Also, please note that the North pool will close at 5:30pm on Sunday, July 31st for the Hurricanes end of the year party.

BROOKHILL DEVELOPMENT OPEN HOUSE

Where: Forest Lakes Pavilion When: Thursday, July 14th Time: 6:00p.m.

Please join us for a review by the developer of their updated plans of the proposed Brookhill Development, located at the intersection of Polo Grounds Road and Route 29 and bordering Forest Lakes South. The property is proposed to be zoned Neighborhood Model District, with over 100 acres of open space and trail systems. The total number of dwelling units will range from a minimum of 800 to a maximum of 1550. As we understand it, that number includes all houses from the low density residential section as well as apartments, condos and townhomes surrounding a solar powered neighborhood center.

In a prior review several months ago, FLCA community members provided their input (strong opposition) to proposed connector roads between Brookhill and Forest Lakes – one in the Coralberry cul-de-sac and one on Ashwood Boulevard behind Ravenscroft and close to Route 29.

The developer's presentation will include updates on those two items, as well as overall density, greenspace protections, a potential new traffic signal on Route 29 and other aspects.

Exhibits will be on display for residents to walk around, view and ask questions you may have.






