

# SPRING BULK PICKUP AND SHREDDING

The on-site shredding facility will be at the North Forest Lakes parking lot from 10:00am - 2:00pm next Friday, April 7th. Bring as much as you want and let the shredder take care of it for you!

Spring Bulk Pick up this year will be next Saturday, April 8th. You may dispose of regular household items such as small furniture, bags of trash, small metal items such as toasters, small television, etc. Please limit your material to weigh no more than 50lbs per item. All Bulk material must be placed at the curb the evening before pickup. Material excluded from pick up are: computers, printers, monitors and like equipment; large appliances such as washers, dryers, water heaters, stoves, or motorized equipment; rocks, concrete, dirt, tires, soil, sod, tree stumps, free liquids, paint, motor oil, construction trash/renovation debris, combustibles, toxic or hazardous wastes, or any other material excluded from the disposal site or any applicable state or federal law as being hazardous or toxic (asbestos, paint or gasoline); all flammable products such as petrol chemicals or propane tanks from barbeque grills, dead animals, fecal matter, manure, brick, landscaping timbers, friable Asbestos, lead acid/wet cell batteries, bio hazardous material, needles and ALL other medical waste.

# **BARKING DOGS**

Just a gentle reminder that barking dogs are a disturbance to your neighbors. This is especially true for people who are retired, work from home, or sleep in the daytime because of shift work. Please kindly be reminded that Forest Lakes HOA and Albemarle County noise nuisance regulations prohibit dogs from barking for extended periods of time throughout the day and night. ### Level I (3 years and up) First class without a parent. Skills include floating, kicking, bobbing, arm movements, breath control, rolling over and safety. All skills are done with support.

Level 2 (3 years and up) Must have completed Level 1 skills. Skills emphasized are rhythmic breathing, unsupported front/back floats and glides, finning, front crawl, elementary backstroke and safety.

Level 3 (5 years and up) Must have completed Level 2 skills. Skills emphasized are front crawl with breathing to side, elementary backstroke, treading water, butterfly kick, scissor kick, survival float and diving.

Level 4 (6 years and up) Must have completed Level 3 skills. Skills emphasized are deep water bobbing, breast stroke, sidestroke, back crawl, butterfly and endurance in front crawl and elementary backstroke.

Level 5 (6 years and up) Must have completed Level 4 skills. Skills emphasized are endurance of previous skills, sculling, shallow and surface dives, flip turns and safety.

# Parent Assisted Classes

Waterbabies/Aquatot (6 mos to 2 yrs) A great first class! Emphasis on water adjustment, safety and supported movement through the water.

**Preschool** (2 years to 3 years) Same skills as aquatot. Emphasis on breath control, jumping-in and beginner forms of propulsion.

Class size: minimum 6 children, maximum 12.

Late registration: Sign up books with listings of open classes will be available at the lifeguard tables at the pools beginning on Monday, May29th.

Swim lessons are taught in **two-week sessions** consisting of eight halfhour classes each session. There are two built-in make-up days per session in case of inclement weather.

Semi-private classes will be offered if there are less than 4 children registered for a class. **Private** lessons are available for children and adults.

Class size: Minimum 4 children; maximum 6 children (except for parent-assisted classes)

Cost: Cost per child per session is \$70.

Robins, flowers, grass, warmer weather...Forest Lakes high school students making their Albemarle High School tennis teams....Forest Lakes youngsters hitting the courts after school....Forest Lakes residents dusting off their rackets and playing tennis.

With the arrival of Spring so too comes NEW CLAY COURT MATERIAL. I am so excited! We will turn the water on (it's been turned off to protect the pipes during winter) mid-April. Then our crew will spread hundreds of pounds of clay court material onto each of our six Clay Tech courts of Forest Lakes North.

With the new material, it's a good time to refresh ourselves on the responsibilities of the tennis players. Please brush and line your court after you play. Hang up the brushes and liners on the fence, well off the ground please. Toss your cups, tennis ball containers and old over grips into the trash. Keep our courts clean.

Speaking of trash... The trashing of the courts by some rogue individuals is really starting to get my goat. Randomly, I have found the paper cups and the dispensers tossed about the courts. There has also been bad words and pictures drawn onto the clay courts with the line brushes. Graffiti has been sprayed onto the Pro Shop and surrounding fences. They are all ordered online by going to the Forest Lakes website at <a href="https://www.forestlakes.net">www.forestlakes.net</a>, clicking on "Association Government" and then on "Selling Your Home". You'll then set up an account. If you have any problems, please ask us!

**Do I need an ARB form for a project I'm doing at my house?** If you are doing anything to the outside of your home, the answer is usually yes. For specific guidelines, you can find them on our website. Or call the office and ask us!

**How do I rent the Poolhouse or Pavilion?** Call the office and ask us if the date you'd like is available. We'll get you all set up! Remember, only Forest Lakes residents can rent the facilities.

Can you give me my account balance and/or account number? Absolutely!

I lost my gym card – how do I get a new one? Come into the office and have cards at the ready. They are \$10 to replace.

When will pool passes come? As long as you have a Resident Information Sheet on file with the office, they are mailed mid-May. Don't have an info sheet on file? Come in the office and fill one out!

I found something on a path, trail or in the gym – do you have a lost and found? Yes we do! If you've found something, bring it in. We're always happy when something lost is found. If you've lost something, don't forget to ask us if we have it!

**Will trash be delayed due to a holiday?** We send out eblasts when our trash will be collected late – it's also posted as an announcement on the website. Still unsure? Ask us! **How do I get onto the website?** You first need to REGISTER with your HOA account number. Then you'll set up a password and you're in!

**How do I get onto the "eblast" list?** You can call or email us with your email address OR you can go straight to the homepage on the website and sign up there!


