DIRECTOR'S LETTER

As you may have seen from various media outlets, the Van der Linde single stream recycle business has stopped operations. Van der Linde was the facility that County Waste (our FLCA trash service contracted through June of 2019) used to help all of our residents with our single stream recycling efforts. As a board, we are focused on the best solution for this unexpected issue. At our March 28th board meeting, we met with some residents and 3 representatives from County Waste, and discussed ways to solve the recycling problem. We learned that "clean" recycling is the industry direction now, better meeting the needs of those companies who create new products from our recycled waste.

The good news is that we do want to continue recycling and have a solution to review. This solution would involve returning to separation of recyclable items. County Waste owns a "clean" recycling facility near Richmond that can process the Forest Lakes recyclables. Some board members plan to visit the facility. We considered other possible solutions, as well. The board will do some additional research and negotiation, as it appears any solution will involve additional cost.

The Board will vote on a final plan of action at our April 25th board meeting. Please be assured that we are keeping everyone's best recycling endeavors in mind.

We will have an update on our decision in the next newsletter and on the website. Our goal is to have a new recycling program in place by June 1st.

SWIM LESSON SIGN UP

Our swim instructors, Jean and Roberta, are experienced Red Cross certified instructors. They are excited and looking forward to another summer to teach your child water safety, proper strokes and the love of swimming!

SPRING BULK PICKUP AND SHREDDING

The on-site shredding facility will be at the North Forest Lakes parking lot from 10:00am–2:00pm on Friday, April 20th. Bring as much as you want and let the shredder take care of it for you!

Spring Bulk Pick up this year will be Saturday, April 21st. You may dispose of regular household items such as small furniture, bags of trash, small metal items such as toasters, small television, etc. Please limit your material to weigh no more than 50lbs per item. All Bulk material must be placed at the curb the evening before pickup. Material excluded from pick up are: computers, printers, monitors and like equipment; large appliances such as washers, dryers, water heaters, stoves, or motorized equipment; rocks, concrete, dirt, tires, soil, sod, tree stumps, free liquids, paint, motor oil, construction

trash/renovation debris, combustibles, toxic or hazardous wastes, or any other material excluded from the disposal site or any applicable state or federal law as being hazardous or toxic (asbestos, paint or gasoline); all flammable products such as petrol chemicals or propane tanks from barbeque grills, dead animals, fecal matter, manure, brick, landscaping timbers, friable Asbestos, lead acid/wet cell batteries, bio hazardous material, needles and ALL other medical waste.

A resident information sheet is in this newsletter to fill out and return to the FLCA office if you have never filled one out or you have changes to your current one on file. This will ensure you receive pool cards for the upcoming pool season!

The Forest Lakes Swim Team is one of 18 summer swim teams in the Jefferson Swim League. We are open to Forest Lake resident swimmers from age 5 (by June 1st) to graduating high school seniors 18 years old.

After school practices begin in mid-May.

Daily morning practices start when Albemarle County public schools end.

Most swim team events are held at the South pool, including six free Saturday stroke instruction clinics.

The mission of FLST is to provide a fun, team oriented summer activity. FLST is a competitive swim team whose goals are to develop a healthy competitive spirit, instill self-discipline, sportsmanship, team goals, spirit and friendship among the swim team members, and introduce swimmers to the year-round sport of swimming.

FLST has six swim meets (three home and three away) with other local teams in the JSL. Our season ends in July, with the JSL Championships at UVA on July 27 & 28, where all swimmers compete.

Level I (3 years and up) First class without a parent. Skills include floating, kicking, bobbing, arm movements, breath control, rolling over and safety. All skills are done with support.

Level 2 (3 years and up) Must have completed Level 1 skills. Skills emphasized are rhythmic breathing, unsupported front/back floats and glides, finning, front crawl, elementary backstroke and safety.

Level 3 (5 years and up) Must have completed Level 2 skills. Skills emphasized are front crawl with breathing to side, elementary backstroke, treading water, butterfly kick, scissor kick, survival float and diving.

Level 4 (6 years and up) Must have completed Level 3 skills. Skills emphasized are deep water bobbing, breast stroke, sidestroke, back crawl, butterfly and endurance in front crawl and elementary backstroke.

Level 5 (6 years and up) Must have completed Level 4 skills. Skills emphasized are endurance of previous skills, sculling, shallow and surface dives, flip turns and safety.

Late registration: Sign up books with listings of open classes will be available at the lifeguard tables at the pools beginning on Sunday, June 3rd.

Swim lessons are taught in **two-week sessions** consisting of eight half-hour classes each session. There are two built-in make-up days per session in case of inclement weather.

Semi-private classes will be offered if there are less than 4 children registered for a class. **Private** lessons are available for children and adults.

Class size: Minimum 4 children; maximum 6 children (except for parent-assisted classes)

Cost: Cost per child per session is \$70.

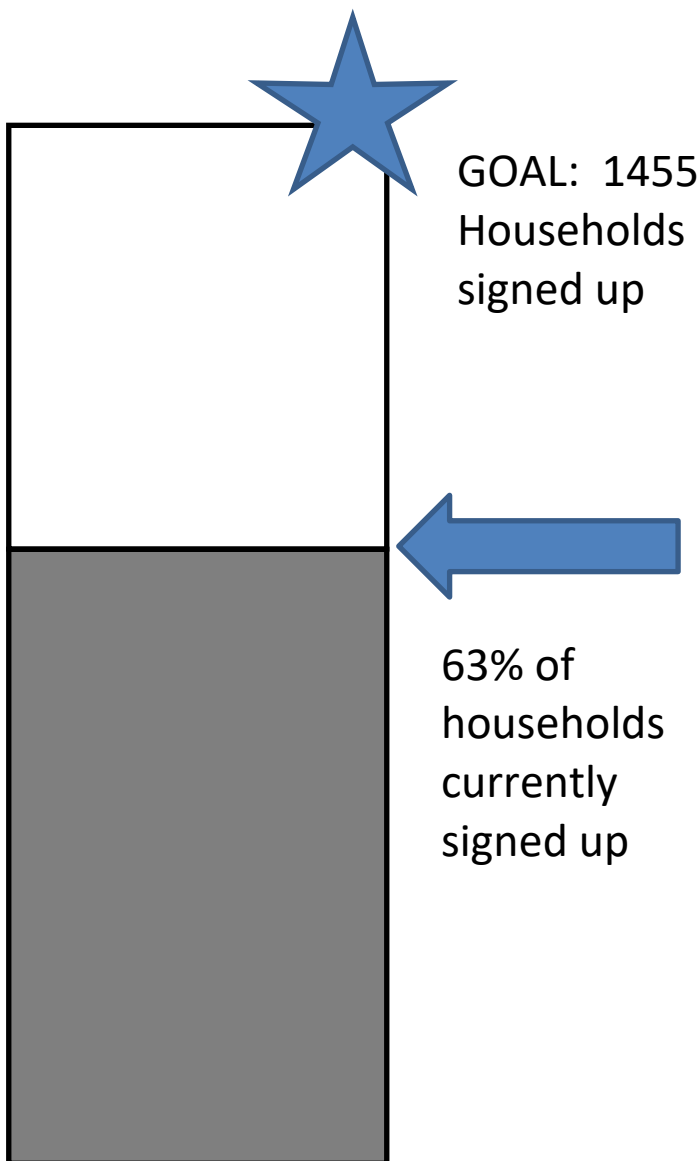

BEGINS Monday, March 12, 2018

Beginners I, II and III (Guidelines) Player has little or no experience. Beginner I is for very young players, Beginner II is for slightly older beginners. Beginners III is for beginners that are 12 or older.

Advanced Beginner (Guidelines) Player must be able to hit 10 balls in a row against backboard from 20 feet away (forehand & backhand), rally with partner from the baseline 10 balls in a row each, serve 5 of 10 balls into appropriate service box, know how to keep score, and play a complete tennis match.

Intermediate (Guidelines) Player must be able to hit 20 balls in a row against backboard from 20 feet away (forehand and backhand), rally from baseline with partner 30 balls in a row, serve 6 of 10 serves to each service box, and must have played at least 5 complete tennis matches. Player must exhibit proper stroke mechanics and grips for all shots and must know the rules of tennis.

Tournament Training (Guidelines) Player must be able to maintain a baseline rally of 40 balls, properly execute volleys and overhands, and be able to execute flat, slice and kick serves. Players should also be training for high school or tournament competition.
