## DIRECTOR'S LETTER

Dear Forest Lakes Homeowners,

May is proving to be a very busy month! There are TWO very important matters that need the attention of ALL homeowners:

**1. Hollymead Dam**—The Albemarle County Board of Supervisors has agreed to assume responsibility for the upgrades and maintenance of the Hollymead Lake Dam which will relieve the homeowners of Forest Lakes of hundreds of thousands of dollars in costs to comply with dam safety requirements. To accomplish this, the Forest Lakes Community Association will need to transfer its interest in the dam and roadway on top of the dam and grant the County easements of access for construction and maintenance over nearby FLCA common areas. To sign these deeds, the FLCA Board of Directors needs authorization by the vote of the homeowners. A mailer is being sent out to all homeowners in May with information on this issue. A homeowners meeting on Wednesday, June 13, 2018 at 6:00 at the Forest Lakes Pavilion has been scheduled. **THIS IS A CRITICAL FINANCIAL AND SAFETY ISSUE NEEDING THE TIMELY SUPPORT AND VOTES OF THE FLCA HOMEOWNERS. YOUR VOTE IS NECESSARY AND CRUCIAL** – both to achieve a quorum and to relieve the FLCA of future financial burdens of maintaining the Lake Hollymead Dam. When you receive your mailer, please review all information enclosed, vote, and either mail your ballot/proxy in the self-addressed envelope, bring it by the FLCA office or bring it to the June meeting. **HOWEVER**, to establish a quorum, we would like your ballot **BEFORE** the June meeting.

**2. Trash and Recycling**—The Forest Lakes Board of Directors entered a new contract with our trash service provider, County Waste, to include clean recycling. The cost of our trash pickup services will increase by \$5.00 per household per month. The FLCA will be absorbing the roughly \$45,000 increase in costs for the remainder of 2018. Separate toters will be delivered to ALL Forest Lakes residents May 21–31 and recycling will begin the first Wednesday pickup in June. There is a “Recycle Education” mini-seminar being offered by County Waste on May 17<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm in the Pavilion.

## POOL OPENING AND POOL CARDS 2018

Pool opening day is Saturday, May 26th! Pool cards will be mailed to all residents the week of May 14th. If you do not receive your cards in the mail, please contact the office. Pool hours will be limited while Albemarle County public schools are still in session. Please see the pool hours flyer in this newsletter. A few pool notes:

- **Cards:** Residents are not to give their cards to anybody else to use our facilities. You **MUST** have your card to enter the pool. No card. No entry.
- **Young Children:** Parents, if you have a child who has a floating device on, water wings, life jacket, etc., you must be within arms reach of your child at all times. It is your responsibility to make sure your child is safe in the water.
- **Parents:** Please go over the pool rules (included in the pool mailer) with your kids, especially those who are receiving youth cards for the first time.
- **Sunscreen:** Please do not lie on the chairs with sunscreen – place a towel between yourself and the chair. Also, take care not to spray sunscreen onto the pool chairs. The sunscreen develops a thick film on the chairs which darkens over time and becomes unsightly.

# Trash and Recycling

## in Forest Lakes – starting this June



As you read in the Director's Column, clean recycling will begin this June in Forest Lakes. There are two flyers provided by County Waste in this newsletter. One describes placement of your recycle toter and the other describes acceptable and unacceptable items for recycling. Please be sure to read both! Below are some other important things to know:

- ❖ Recycle Toters will be delivered to all Forest Lakes homes 21-31 May by County Waste.
- ❖ The recycle collection day will be the same day as trash day (Wednesdays). **THE KEY THING TO REMEMBER IS TOTER PLACEMENT. Toters must be at least 5 feet apart and have at least 5 feet clearance from mailboxes, poles, lampposts, etc.** Please read the flyer in this newsletter on this topic.
- ❖ Absolutely NO plastic bags are allowed to be recycled. They get tangled up in the machines and are a huge hindrance. Many grocery stores have plastic bag recycle bins outside their stores, or better yet, use fabric reusable bags!
- ❖ A "Recycle Education" mini-seminar will be presented by County Waste on THURSDAY, MAY 17<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm at the Forest Lakes Pavilion. Please come to get informed and to discuss any questions you may have about our new recycling program!

### **WHAT IS AUTOMATED COLLECTION?**

Automated collection is a unique system of residential refuse and recycling removal. Automated trucks are equipped with lifting mechanisms that easily empty specialized carts. Homes are provided with carts that are rolled to the end of the driveway the evening before collection day.

### **NEAT, CLEAN & EASY!**

- The wheeled carts are easy to maneuver – no more lifting or dragging heavy cans!
- Clean and neat looking neighborhoods with uniform containers!
- No more animals knocking over cans or the wind blowing off lids!

### **IMPORTANT!**

*Please read the following:*

- Please use carts for this coming week's pick-up. Wheel carts to the end of your driveway and set approximately 5 feet from each other, as shown below. Carts should also have approximately 5 feet clearance from mailboxes, poles and lampposts. Be sure to place all refuse and recycling in specified containers.
- Additional charges may apply to any extra bags outside the refuse cart. Prices vary depending on the size of each bag.
- Additional charges also apply to any bulk items outside or near your refuse cart. Each charge varies depending on the item being picked up. Please do not put anything you do not wish to be picked up near your carts; for example, lawn chairs, portable basketball hoops, bicycles, etc. For pricing and scheduling of bulk items wished to be removed, please call our Customer Service Department.

*Place your recycling cart at least 5 feet away from your trash cart so our automated trucks may easily collect your trash and recycling.*

The Tropical Storms is a five week development program of the Forest Lakes Hurricanes Swim Team (FLST). It is designed to be an introduction to the competitive swim team. This program will provide the basics of competitive swim strokes. This program is not a substitute for swim lessons.

Tropical Storms are for children 4 years old and all new swimmers under 7 years old.

The program will introduce young swimmers to the swim team style of swimming and advance them to be able to swim at least 1 pool length (25 meters) of Freestyle and Backstroke. This 45-minute practice is intended to be an introduction to the swim team. The Tropical Storms goal is to encourage as many young swimmers to enjoy the swimming sport in a fun and friendly environment. They will practice 3 times a week, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday from 12:00-12:45 at the South Pool.

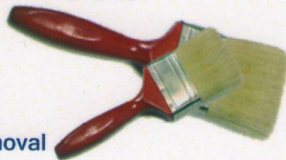



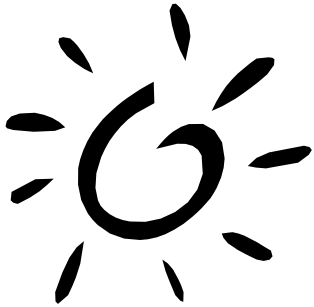

### Parent Assisted Classes

**Waterbabies/Aquatot** (6 mos to 2 yrs) A great first class! Emphasis on water adjustment, safety and supported movement through the water.

**Preschool** (2 years to 3 years) Same skills as aquatot. Emphasis on breath control, jumping-in and beginner forms of propulsion.

Class size: minimum 6 children, maximum 12.

**Level I** (3 years and up) First class without a parent. Skills include floating, kicking, bobbing, arm movements, breath control, rolling over and safety. All skills are done with support.

**Level 2** (3 years and up) Must have completed Level 1 skills. Skills emphasized are rhythmic breathing, unsupported front/back floats and glides, finning, front crawl, elementary backstroke and safety.

**Level 3** (5 years and up) Must have completed Level 2 skills. Skills emphasized are front crawl with breathing to side, elementary backstroke, treading water, butterfly kick, scissor kick, survival float and diving.

**Level 4** (6 years and up) Must have completed Level 3 skills. Skills emphasized are deep water bobbing, breast stroke, sidestroke, back crawl, butterfly and endurance in front crawl and elementary backstroke.

**Level 5** (6 years and up) Must have completed Level 4 skills. Skills emphasized are endurance of previous skills, sculling, shallow and surface dives, flip turns and safety.

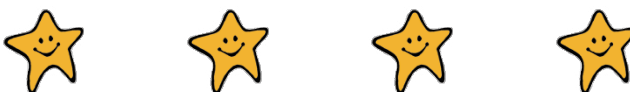
**Late registration:** Sign up books with listings of open classes will be available at the lifeguard tables at the pools beginning on Sunday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Swim lessons are taught in **two-week sessions** consisting of eight half-hour classes each session. There are two built-in make-up days per session in case of inclement weather.

**Semi-private** classes will be offered if there are less than 4 children registered for a class. **Private** lessons are available for children and adults.

**Class size:** Minimum 4 children; maximum 6 children (except for parent-assisted classes)

**Cost:** Cost per child per session is \$70.
