POOL NEWS

Our pools are up and running! We had another successful opening on Memorial Day weekend, despite the less than perfect weather! Pool hours will begin on a "normal" schedule beginning Thursday, June 8th. Please see the Pool Hours flyer in this newsletter for details.

Please remember to always bring your pool cards with you when coming to the pool – no card, no entry! Pool cards must not be given to nonresidents for use at any time. If you are bringing guests to the pool, you must stay with them the entire visit. When you leave, your guests must leave.

Early morning lap swim begins on Tuesday, June 12th at the South Pool from 6:30-7:30am. The pool will be open for Forest Lakes adults only (bring your pool card!) on Tuesdays and Thursdays through July.

FROM THE DESK OF TENNIS DIRECTOR, JIM LABINSKI

Dear Forest Lakes residents, parents and junior tennis players,

The Clay Tech courts of North Forest Lakes have been re-nourished for the summer season of tennis playing. Nearly 1000 pounds of new clay material has been added to each court.

It is a good time to remind everyone of the responsibilities of every tennis-playing resident!

- Please be considerate of other residents and brush/line your court after playing. Hang up the brushes and liners on the fence, well off the ground. (Hang up the squeegees on the fences at South.) Deposit all your cups, tennis ball cans and other garbage in the receptacles provided.
- Don't let young children "play" with the court equipment. They do a terrible job of lining the courts!
- Be respectful of others playing. Don't just "jump on a court" because it is open. Check the reservation sheets at the Pro Shop to make sure that the court isn't already taken.
- Don't play on courts when there is standing water on them. It is dangerous and can mess up the courts for later play.

The **Summer Tennis Camp** will commence on June 11. Four-week, nine-week and single-week packages are available. One- two- and three-hour options are available. Please email me or stop by the Pro Shop at North to get forms and more information.

The Clay Tech courts play best when they have been watered. Come a little bit early and give the courts a good bit of water before playing on them. You will enjoy the experience much more.

Annually, I spend over \$1000 on tennis balls! Players hit balls over the fence all the time. They are not for the taking! Please leave them on the ground or throw them back onto the courts when there is a stoppage of play. I appreciate it.

Remember: tennis courts are for TENNIS! Tennis courts are NOT for bicycles, soccer, dog training or baseball batting practice. There are about thirty more activities that shouldn't take place on the courts, but hopefully you get the idea—TENNIS only please!

Through the efforts of John Oliver, esteemed Forest Lakes resident and tennis nut, we have a tennis ball recycling program. When your tennis balls have lost their life, drop them in the bin provided outside the Pro Shop. When it is full, they are sent off to be recycled. We have already filled up one bin and it has been shipped. Thanks, John O.

As always, I offer restringing and regripping services. Now is the time to get your racket tuned up for the upcoming warm weather.

Finally, from time to time, I will ask players if they are Forest Lakes Residents. Please don't be offended—I'm just doing my job. It has come to my attention that non-residents sneak on the courts occasionally. If there are people playing that are not residents, politely ask them to leave or tell me and I will do so. Some former Forest Lakes residents occasionally jump on the courts, but they must be with a current resident or they will be given the boot!

The Tropical Storms is a five week development program of the Forest Lakes Hurricanes Swim Team (FLST). It is designed to be an introduction to the competitive swim team. This program will provide the basics of competitive swim strokes. This program is not a substitute for swim lessons.

Tropical Storms are for children 4 years old and all <u>new</u> swimmers under 7 years old.

The program will introduce young swimmers to the swim team style of swimming and advance them to be able to swim at least 1 pool length (25 meters) of Freestyle and Backstroke. This 45-minute practice is intended to be an introduction to the swim team. The Tropical Storms goal is to encourage as many young swimmers to enjoy the swimming sport in a fun and friendly environment. They will practice 3 times a week, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday from 12:00-12:45 at the South Pool.
